Registration 2023 - 2024 Incoming 9th Grade Instructions

Today marks the start of registration for the 2023 - 2024 school year. Please take this process seriously and plan thoughtfully. The decisions you make in regards to registration have a large impact not only on yourself, but also on the school as a whole. The courses that you register for are a commitment for the entire school year. At the beginning of the 4th Quarter, we will open a window for students to request changes to their initial registration. Once the new school year begins, only changes due to incorrect placement will be allowed.

Registration Night Information

All parents and students are invited to attend our Registration Night held on Thursday, January 5, 2023, beginning at 5:30pm in the Moanalua High School Cafeteria. We will start with a presentation with general information about the registration process and graduation requirements, followed by breakout sessions around campus, hosted by teachers of various departments and elective courses.

You will be submitting the elective courses you would like to take for the 2023 - 2024 school year through a Google Form. Please follow these steps to help make the registration process go as smoothly as possible.

- 1. Decide what courses you would like to take next year.** Here are some documents that can help you select courses.
 - a. [9th Grade Course Guide](#)** - *These are the courses that most incoming 9th Grade students will be able to register for. Your current core teachers will submit their recommendations for your English, Social Studies, Math and Science courses directly to Moanalua High School.*
 - b. Full Course Catalog - *Need info about classes?*** Our course catalog and other information can be found at bit.ly/MoHS_Reg9th. *This is a full list of courses, their descriptions and prerequisite(s) that are needed to sign up for a given course. (Course Catalog directly available at bit.ly/2324Catalog)*
- 2. Talk to your current teachers.** Your current teachers are making recommendations for your English, Social Studies, Math and Science classes for next year. You may talk to them about whether or not they have recommended an honors class for you.
- 3. Discuss your choices with your parents.** Make sure they know what courses you are signing up for and that they approve of your choices. You will also need their contact information for the online registration form.
- 4. Complete the Moanalua HS 9th Grade Registration Google Form.** The link to this form will be emailed to the student's school email account and will have to be filled out through that email account. Enter all the information carefully, as any mistakes in your form may affect the courses you are placed into.
To the parents: Forms must be filled out using the student's school account, but the form will also ask for your (the parent's) email address. Upon submitting the form, you should receive an email within a few hours (you may need to check your spam folder) with the results of the form for your own records.

The online registration form must be submitted by **January 12, 2023 @ 11:59pm**. Failure to submit your form on time may result in not getting your electives.
